WEEKLY GAS PRICE REVIEW

87 Octane price increased by 1.04% (J\$1.73) this week to J\$168.37. The gas price opened the year 2023 at J\$163.41, an increase of J\$4.96 year to date.

90 Octane price increased by 1.31% (J\$2.23) this week to J\$172.40. The gas price opened the year 2023 at J\$167.39, an increase of J\$5.01 year to date.

Diesel price increased by 1.66% (J\$2.63) this week to J\$161.29. The gas price opened the year 2023 at J\$208.84, a decrease of J\$47.55 year to date.

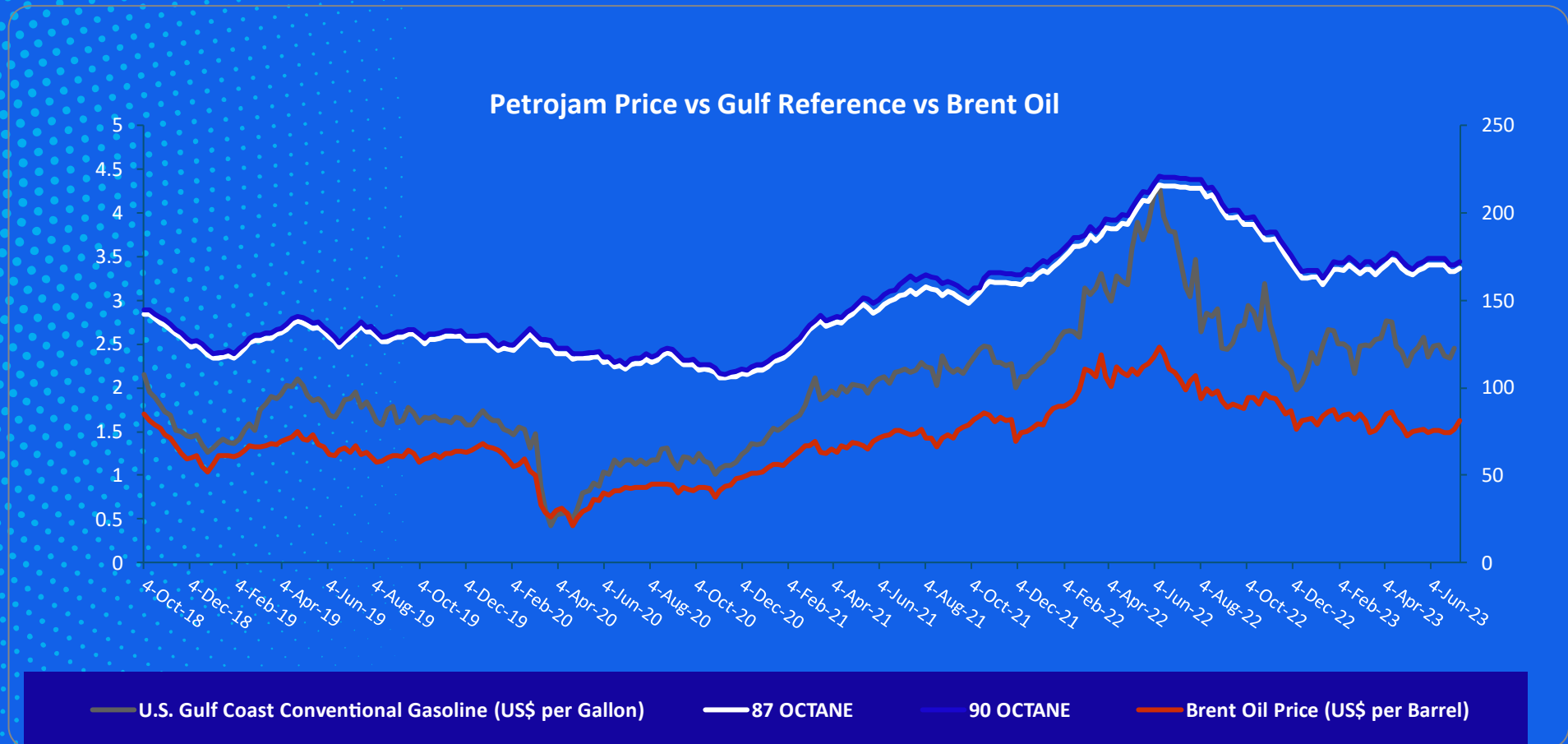

Brent Oil

WEEKLY GAS PRICE REVIEW

Brent oil price increased by 6% (US\$4.59) relative to the prior week. Oil traded on July 13, 2023 at US\$81.11 per barrel relative to US\$76.52 on July 6, 2023. Brent oil opened the year 2023 at US\$78.69 per barrel and has increased by 3.08% (US\$2.42) year to date.





This Week in Petroleum

Majority of U.S. Average Regular Gasoline Prices and Diesel Prices Increased

On July 10, 2023, the U.S. average regular gasoline retail price rose by 2 cents to \$3.55 per gallon, \$1.10 lower relative to a year ago. The East Coast price increased by 6 cents to \$3.43 per gallon. The Midwest price decreased by 3 cents to \$3.36 per gallon. The Gulf Coast price increased by 4 cents to \$3.15 per gallon. The Rocky Mountain price decreased by 4 cents to \$3.75 per gallon. The West Coast price increased by less than 1 cent to \$4.53 per gallon.

The average diesel fuel price increased by 4 cents to \$3.81 per gallon on July 10, 2023, \$1.76 lower than a year ago. The East Coast price increased by 5 cents to \$3.86 per gallon. The Midwest price increased by 4 cents to \$3.74 per gallon. The Gulf Coast price increased by 4 cents to \$3.51 per gallon. The Rocky Mountain price decreased by 1 cent to \$3.94 per gallon. The West Coast price increased by 5 cents to \$4.46 per gallon.



This Week in Petroleum (cont'd)

Most Inventories for Propane/Propylene Increased

There was an increase in U.S. propane/propylene stocks last week by approximately 2.67 million barrels to 83.79 million barrels as of July 7, 2023, approximately 25.99 million barrels more than the average inventory levels a year ago to date.

Additionally, East Coast, Midwest, and Gulf Coast inventories increased by 0.18 million barrels, 1.28 million barrels and 1.22 million barrels, respectively. Rocky Mountain/West Coast inventories decreased by 0.003 million barrels.
